### AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of the entry, I agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the American Kennel Club in effect at the time of the event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing on the premium list of this event and any form and any condition made in connection with this entry. I agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause when the club itself deems sufficient. I agree to certify and represent that the dog entered is not a member of persons or other dogs, in consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, trophies, or trophies. I agree to hold the AKC, the sponsoring club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, breeders, trainers or event associates and the owner under license of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the sponsoring club, parties, and any AKC approved judges, judges of this event, harmless from any claim for loss of injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly in any position or thing by the dog at the dog show or at the event premises or grounds or near the entrance thereto, and I (and previously persons all responsibility and liability in any such claim, which read) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for any claim to indemnify, defend and hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage, because of bodily injury, including death, to any third person resulting from, sustained by one person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or as a result of damage to property arising out of or in connection with my (our) participation in this event, however such injury, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, CONDUCT OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BE VALUED THE AKC AND THE EVENT Sponsoring Club UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN THIS PREMIUM LIST AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE ASSOCIATION AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PROCEDURES AND POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

### INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular Ring classes, but not in a class or lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher (taller) than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Class may still compete; however, they must be measured by a judge of record, or by a Field Representative, or a volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the judge of record, that measurement will be valid for the trial and owner's book only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the handler's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners® program may be eligible to enter all listed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior (and/or name) on the form of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-2767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog, identify on the form on this form what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the handler?
