Entry Limitations – According to Chapter 1, Section 27 of the AKC Obedience Regulations, each judge will be limited to a maximum number of **7½ hours** of judging time per day. Entries will be limited based on the maximum number of dogs allowed per hour for each class according to the Obedience Regulations. **Entries will be taken in the order received.** Entries for classes assigned to a judge will automatically close if the judging limit is reached, even if it is before the trial closing date. **The UDX class is offered:** Once the limit has been reached in either the Open B or the Utility B class, the UDX class will be considered closed, and any subsequent entries for this class will be unacceptable in their entirety. Please indicate if yours is a UDX entry on your form if you do not wish to be entered in fewer classes. **When each trial reaches entry or judging time limits, a wait list will be maintained until the closing date.**

Notice to Exhibitors

Entries for the trials open Monday, April 20, 2026. Entries received before that date will not be accepted. Entries close at 6 PM on Wednesday, June 3, 2026, at the Trial Secretary's office or when numerical or time limits are reached, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. When each trial reaches entry or judging time limits, **a wait-list will be maintained until the closing date.** Please indicate if yours is a UDX entry on your form if you do not wish to be entered in fewer classes.

Make All Checks and Money Orders payable to Cleveland All-Breed Training Club (CABTC) in US funds. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Please use black or blue ink on all checks.

Telegraph, Telephone, and Unsigned Entries Cannot be Accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms, or photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as possible after trial closes.

Acknowledgement of entries and a judging program will be made available as soon as possible after entries close. Paper copies will only be mailed by request. Should acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary (440) 241-9290 – Email crigotti24@gmail.com

Postdated Checks and Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. CABTC will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort will be made to find duplicate entries; however, if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Declination of Entries. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. CABTC may decline any entries and may remove any dog because of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim against CABTC or any official thereof.

Entry Fees Shall Not be Refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of **the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entries will be made.**

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in the filling out of entry forms. Corrections cannot be made after the closing date. Please be certain that you fill in the right class and have the correct jump height on your entries. No entry and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors, or for cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please type or print carefully on entry forms to eliminate errors.

Bitches who come into season after the closing date may have their entry fees refunded, less \$5.00 each day, upon written certification by a Veterinarian. Notification MUST be made to the Trial Secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial.

Exhibitors are Responsible for the Behavior of Their Dogs and/or Children. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when they are called to be judged. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused.

From the West: Take the Ohio Turnpike to Exit 15 which is the 480 Exit East. Take I-480 East to Route 176 North.

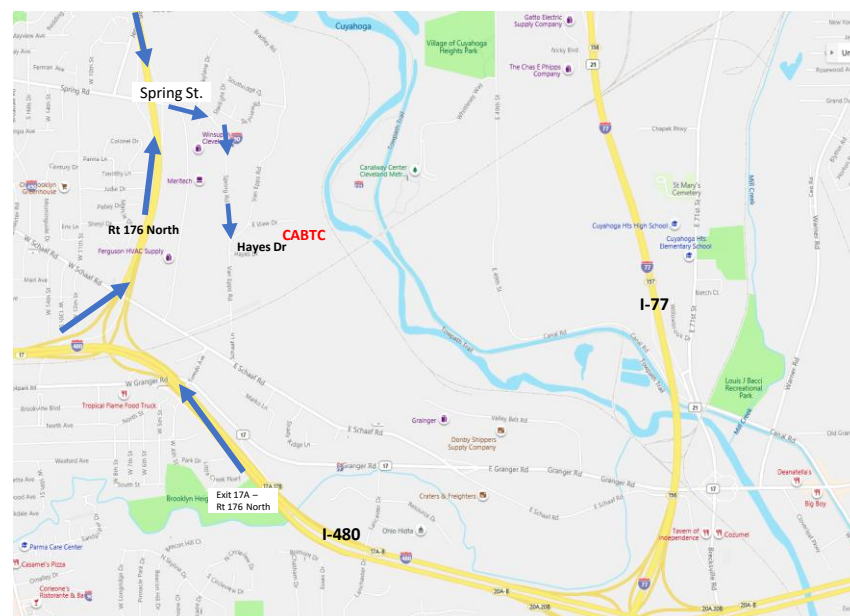
From Route 176 North: The very next exit is Spring Road/Hinckley Parkway. Turn right on to Spring Road/Hinckley Parkway.

Panel dividers and ring gates will be used between the two obedience rings

Obedience Transfers will be allowed Per Chapter 1, Section 16a & 16b of the AKC Obedience Regulations and as stipulated below:

- Any requests for Transfers prior to the trial weekend must be received by the Trial Secretary by 6pm Monday, June 15, 2026.
- Transfers will be allowed as per AKC Rules & Regulations between Saturday to Sunday ONLY and must be received by the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes after the last dog completes the respective trial on Saturday. **NO SAME DAY TRANSFERS**

Open "B" and Utility "B" Exhibitors

When entering Open B and Utility B for UDX qualifying scores, indicate on the entry form obedience class box 'UDX' if you want to enter the trial only if you can get into both Open B and Utility B. If you do so and if one or both classes has already filled, your entry (with fees) will be returned. See chapter 1, section 26 of the AKC Obedience Regulations.

Open & Utility Jump Heights

Jump heights are required to be specified on your entry form. Obedience running order will be arranged in order by the height specified. Running order will be low to high. Handlers with multiple entries in the same class and with the same jump height will be accommodated.

- When the same dog is entered in more than one class, only the highest score will be used for determining the top awards in trial.

This entry is submitted for acceptance on the foregoing representation and agreement. I (we) agree to conduct myself (ourselves) in accordance with all such Rules and Regulations (including all provisions applying to discipline) and to abide by any decisions made in accord with them.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- Variety: If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color). Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.). Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- Event Class: Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., A or B division. Checking “UDX Entry” indicates you do not accept a partial entry in the event other applicable Class is full.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
- Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience Trials at the club’s option. These dogs should be listed as All-American dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC Number box. Sire and dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

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If this entry is for Junior Showmanship, please give the following information:
